



Individuals with Social Anxiety Disorder Needed for a Study

The University of Kansas Hoglund Brain Imaging Center and the Kansas City Center for Anxiety Treatment are seeking individuals with Social Anxiety Disorder for a study examining brain activation during face viewing

Eligibility: You may be eligible if you are 18-50 years old and have social anxiety symptoms.

What is involved: Completion of questionnaires assessing psychological symptoms such as depression and anxiety, diagnostic interview, and fMRI scan.

Two sessions:

- 1) initial assessment to determine eligibility
- 2) study session, which will include the fMRI scan

Remuneration of \$50 will be offered for completion of the fMRI scan. You may also receive a black and white printed picture of your brain obtained by MRI.
